In the Matter of the Minutes: Motion was made by Bob Shirts to accept the minutes of the March 9, 2021, meeting as written. Second by Curtis Hickey motion carries unanimous.

General Business

Review of District Expenditures-Bonnie presented an expenditure activity report dated 3/09/2021: Cash balance is \$32,773.29 budget balance remaining =\$42,749.61.

Tail Bounty Report- October 1, 2020 to date: a total of 6,373 tails (per weed office report) have been received with \$7,966.25 expended on tail bounty, leaving a bounty balance of \$23,033.75. Motion was made by Bob Shirts to accept the reports as presented, second by Curtis Hickey, motion carries unanimous.

Trapping Seminar-The board discussed how the seminar went. 94 flyers were mailed. 46 signed in and expenditures without door prizes, weed personnel and portables toilets is \$490.66. Bonnie reported several people suggested we do this every other year. Approximately 18 people completed the surveys. The board deemed the workshop a success.

New Business

2022 Rodent District Budget-Bonnie reviewed the 2022 budget proposal with the board. She is requesting a 3% salary increase for the secretary =\$185.70. This could have a small impact on the benefits line items. That is the only change she is suggesting. The board is fine with this.
