Chairman Hickey called the meeting to order at 4:10 pm. A quorum is present.

In the Matter of the Minutes: Motion was made by Troy Mock to accept the minutes of the May 11, 2021, meeting as written. Second by Bob Shirts motion carries unanimous.

General Business

Review of District Expenditures-Bonnie presented an expenditure activity report dated 7/13/2021: Cash balance is \$27,196.42 budget balance remaining =\$33,709.37.

Tail Bounty Report- October 1, 2020 to date: a total of 10,600 tails (per weed office report) have been received with \$13,250 expended on tail bounty, leaving a bounty balance of \$17,750. Motion was made by Troy Mock to accept the reports as presented, second by Bob Shirts, motion carries unanimous.

Trapping Seminar-2021 expenses to the weed department for the Saturday seminar is a total of \$558.43. Discussion of attendees and the general consensus of the seminar.

2022 Rodent District Budget-Bonnie updated the board on the increase to the wages line item to allow for the appropriate wage increase for the weed department secretary. This is a result of the budget workshops that were held in June. During the workshop it was realized that we need to increase our hourly rate of pay in order to compete in the job market today.

New Business

Board Terms-Bonnie reported that Troy Mock is up for reappointment at the end of the year. Troy has agreed to continue on the board. A letter will be prepared for the Chairman's signature at the September meeting.

The next Rodent District Meeting will be held Tuesday, September 14, 2021 to be held at 4 p.m. at the Weed Department.
