The Sale Office is Located inside the Sale Barn and will be open at 11am, Saturday, August 7th.

Buyers

Buyers need to register at the Sale Office. You will be assigned a Buyer Number to use during the sale. Buyers may pay at the Livestock Sale, or be billed, payment due in full August 15th, 2021.

Bidding Procedure

All animals are sold by the pound except rabbits and chickens; which will be sold by the pen. If you are the winning bidder on an animal at the sale you have two options as the buyer:

Keep

The **Keep** option is the most straight-forward. You are buying the animal and must choose a butcher. If the butcher is on our list, your animal will be hauled with all animals going to that processor. If you choose a butcher not on the list (below), you are responsible for making arrangement for hauling. As you are keeping the whole animal, you are responsible for the whole price, which is the total pounds times the bid price.

Buyer must clearly designate meat processor and contact them with cutting instructions. Buyer will pay for any kill fee and/or packing fee charged by the meat processor. It is the buyer's responsibility to accept carcass as graded.

Turn Back

The **Turn Back** option allows you to provide financial support to the 4-H/FFA member, but not take ownership of the animal nor receive any meat. You simply pay the difference between the "**Floor Price**" and the "**Bid Price**". The floor buyer has made arrangements to purchase all animals not kept for the predetermined "Floor Price".

Ownership

If the buyer keeps the animal, they become the legal owner of the animal when bidding is closed. However, 4-H and FFA members will be responsible for their animals until livestock is loaded for transportation.

Sample of Average Animal's "Keep" Price Compared to "Turn Back"

Steer: 1,250#	Bid Price \$2.00/#	Total Cost \$2,500.00	Floor \$1.18/# \$1,475.00	Cost to Buyer: \$1,025.00
Swine: 250#	Bid Price \$3.25/#	Total Cost \$812.50	Floor \$.45/# \$112.50	Cost to Buyer: \$700.00
Sheep: 110#	Bid Price \$5.00/#	Total Cost \$550.00	Floor \$.70/# \$77.00	Cost to Buyer: \$473.00
Goats: 70#	Bid Price \$3.50/#	Total Cost \$245.00	Floor \$1.10/# \$77.00	Cost to Buyer: \$168.00
